#### I. Use of Spares

There must be at least 2 registered team members of the team available for an official game. Should a team have less than 2 registered team members available the game may still be played but the result will be awarded to the opposing team. In the event that a team's "Skip" is not available for a game then another registered team member must act as Skip for the game and throw last rocks. A "spare" may play any position other than that of "Skip."
